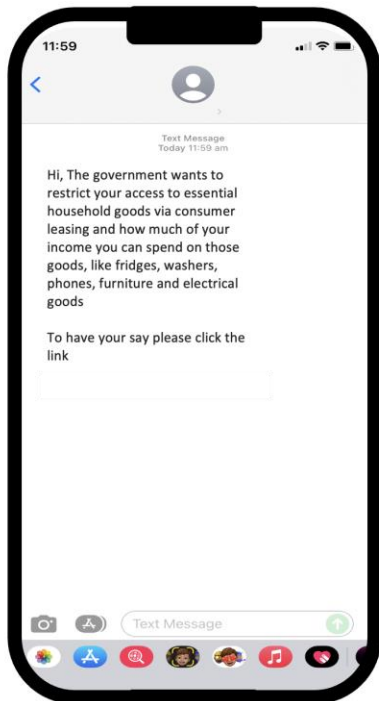


CONSUMER LEASE CUSTOMER SURVEY

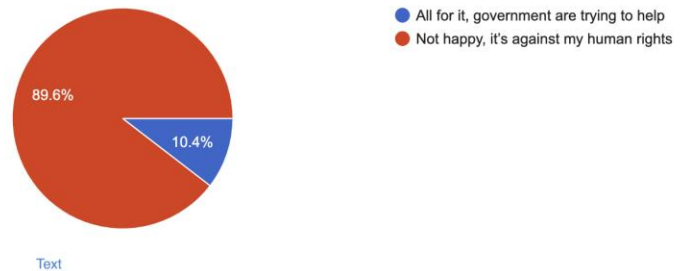
Survey - 95.1% of Customer Respondents Reject 10% Protected Earnings CAP

Research conducted on 6 October 2022 with our customer base including over 1,000 respondents, clearly rejects the proposed Financial Sector Reform Bill 2022 relating to consumer leases. The question below was asked via SMS to around 5,000 customers (see image below) resulting in the responses shown.

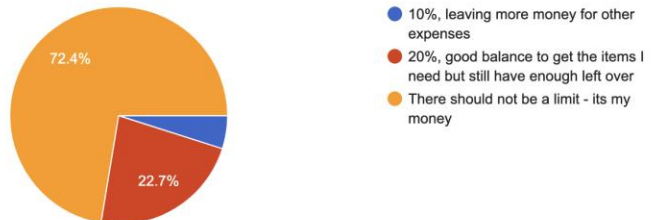
72% of respondents believe there should be no government interference in how they spend their money and

Conclusion: less than 5% support the governments Bill regarding the 10% protected earnings amount.
